Dear Parishioners:

St. Mary's Ukrainian Catholic Church, you may remember, was in need of repairs to its roof. Additionally, the leaking roof necessitated repairs to the church interior caused by water damage. The estimated cost of the repairs was \$120,000. Last February the church community was challenged to raise the funds to help offset the cost of the project.

I am pleased to report that, thanks to the generosity of numerous individual and group donations, our church has successfully met yet another challenge. The roof has been repaired as has the damage to its interior. The total cost, to both the interior and the exterior, was \$128,237.39. Donations and fundraising events raised \$110,548.28. With the insurance claim for interior damage of \$16,011.09, total available funds are \$126,559.37, leaving a shortfall of \$1,678.02.

We asked for your commitment to continue building our community of faith and that you take pride in our Church and ensure that it be maintained for future generations. Almost 200 individual and 11 group donors rose to the occasion.

We, the Finance Committee, on behalf of all church parishioners, sincerely thank all donors for their generous contributions. St. Mary's Ukrainian Catholic Church remains a vibrant, healthy and meaningful Church within the Sudbury community of faith.
