




DIVINE LITURGY MASS REQUESTS: Special Intention Envelopes are available on the table at the main entrance of the church. It is important as prayerful people to remember to submit Prayer Intentions for the health and salvation of the sick, and for the remembrance of the deceased members of your families on the anniversary of their death. Special Intention Mass envelopes are used to request various intentions such as Thanksgiving to God for special blessings and goodness in our lives from God, and also to ask God's help. There are special prayers said in the Divine Liturgy when requesting a Special Intention Divine Liturgy.

DID YOU KNOW? ... There are numerous manmade chemicals used to make perfumed & scented personal use products. Those chemicals can negatively affect your health. Many of our parishioners now suffer from headaches, and allergic reactions and asthma from scented cosmetics, lotions & creams, talcum powders, cologne, perfumes and after-shave products that people wear to church. Regrettably some forget and need to be reminded, ***“Please kindly do not wear scented or perfumed products to church.”*** “When you wear a perfumed product it lingers in the air for several hours after you have left the church, making it uncomfortable for others. It is an additional expense to air out the church. St Mary's Parish Council has already passed a motion to support, an environment free of “Scented and Perfumed Cosmetics personal use Products.”

Ukrainian Catholic Subdeacon to Head Harper Government's New Office of Religious Freedom - Prime Minister Stephen Harper today announced the establishment of the Office of Religious Freedom within the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade, which will be dedicated to promoting freedom of religion or belief around the world. He also announced the appointment of Dr. Andrew Bennett as Ambassador to the Office. Under Ambassador Bennetts leadership, the Office which is now operational will promote freedom of religion or belief as a Canadian foreign policy priority. The Office will be an important vehicle through which Canada can advance fundamental Canadian values including freedom, democracy, human rights and the rule of law worldwide. Our Government is dedicated to promoting the freedom and prosperity of the people it serves, added the Prime Minister. We will work with other countries and all people of goodwill, to promote the principles we share. Specifically, the Office will focus on advocacy, analysis, policy development and programming relating to: protecting and advocating on behalf of religious minorities under threat; opposing religious hatred and intolerance; and, promoting Canadian values of pluralism and tolerance abroad.
