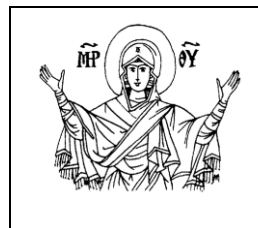

**BLESSING OF HOMES** – continues this week.

Vatican Radio) "Thank you, thank you from my heart. I am happy to be here with you, surrounded by the beauty of Creation and your friendship that does me so much good, thank you for your friendship, for caring. You know that today is different from others... as of eight pm I will no longer be the Supreme Pontiff of the Catholic Church. I will simply be a pilgrim who is beginning the last part of his pilgrimage on earth. But with my heart, my love, my prayer, with all my inner strength, I will work for the common good and the good of the Church and all humanity. And I feel greatly supported by your affection. Let us move forward together with the Lord for the good of the Church and the world. I will now impart upon you all my Apostolic Blessing Thank you and good night. Thank you all" This was how Benedict XVI brought to an end the long goodbye that has accompanied the final weeks of his Pontificate. Emer McCarthy reports:  
As the bells of Rome continued to peal in salute to the 264th Successor of St Peter and the sun set behind the tiny hill-top town of Castel Gandolfo, the figure of Benedict XVI slipped behind the curtains of the central balcony of the Apostolic Palace in Castel Gandolfo. It was his last public appearance as Pope. The crowds below continued to cheer as further north, in St Peter's Square, thousands more huddled around the giant screens, many shaking their heads, with tears in their eyes.  
"Thank you for your love and support. May you always experience the joy that comes from putting Christ at the centre of your lives", read his last tweet, sent moments before he lifted off from the Vatican heliport for the Papal Summer Residence, high in the Vatican Gardens. Vatican officials and lay staff from his chauffeur, to the squadron of gardeners struggling to contain their emotion as they bid him farewell.  
As of 20:00, the See of Peter will be vacant. Benedict XVI will now retire into a secluded life of prayer and meditation, at first remaining in Castel Gandolfo before retiring to a monastery in the Vatican gardens.

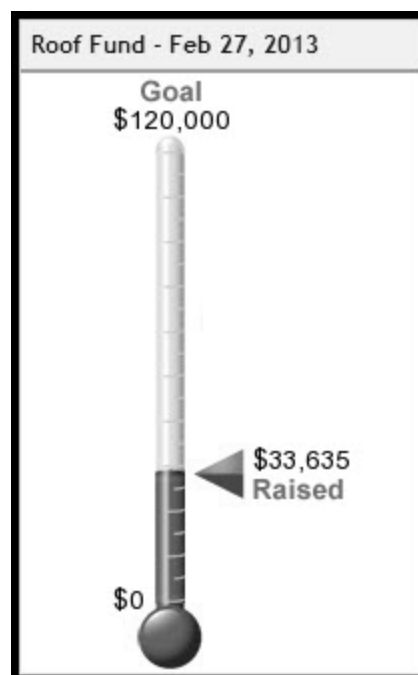

**DIVINE LITURGY MASS REQUESTS:** Envelopes are available on the table in the main entrance of the church. It is important as prayerful people to remember to submit Prayer Intentions for the health and salvation of the sick, and for the remembrance of the deceased members of your families on the anniversary of their death. Special Intention Mass envelopes are used to request various intentions such as Thanksgiving to God for special blessings and goodness in our lives from God, and also to ask God's help. There are special prayers said in the Divine Liturgy when requesting a Special Intention Divine Liturgy.

**ADDITIONAL EASTER SCHEDULE ACCORDING TO THE GREGORIAN CALENDAR:** St Mary's will be adding the celebration of **Good Friday on March 29<sup>th</sup> and Easter Sunday on March 31<sup>st</sup> according to the Gregorian calendar.** Many families and children gather together and are celebrating Easter in March because their work and school holidays are scheduled according to the Gregorian calendar. Kindly understand that the Julian Calendar Easter schedule will also be celebrated according to the Julian calendar in May.

**Easter Flowers Donations:** Donations for Easter Flowers may be made in memory of your loved ones and deceased family members. Please use a special Donation envelope and clearly indicate the deceased person's name on the envelope and along with your donation for the Easter flowers. **NEW IN THE PEWS ... FOR READING BEFORE OR AFTER DIVINE LITURGY** ***"The Vibrant Parish – A Place to Encounter the Living Christ."*** This Pastoral letter of His Beatitude Sviatoslav has been written to the clergy, religious and all of us faithful. "The goal of this program is to help all the faithful of our Church to learn "to live in order to please God." (1 Th 4:1), and thus to grow in holiness and unity in Christ Jesus. Each person has a personal responsibility to grow in faith and understanding, and as faithful we need to read and to take the time to understand and meditate on this very important Pastor Letter. **IS IT OK TO HAVE CONVERSATIONS OR TALK IN THE CHURCH NAVE BEFORE OR AFTER DIVINE LITURGY OR MASS? ... The answer is No!** Out of great reverence and respect for God in the Byzantine Ukrainian Catholic we do not talk or conduct conversations in the church nave either before or after the celebration of Divine Liturgies. Why? ... In the Byzantine Ukrainian Catholic Church we do not talk in the church nave out of great reverence for God and because we are in the presence of God. The church nave is a special place of prayer reserved to be with God. We can visit friends by phone, Internet, in the church hall or parking lot etc. Inside the church we need to focus on the fact that we are in the presence of God and that it is God who we are called to visit the nave. In our Tradition other than in liturgical services we are silent inside the church.

**NARTHEX:** If you find it necessary to talk in the Narthex or Entrance of the church kindly please speak quietly & softly as your conversations can at times be easily heard inside the church. The Narthex entrance ceiling is open, and sound is amplified due to the curved sanctuary walls.
